80th Anniversary of Swiss Circle Sri Lanka - a summary

President Arlette Palmer and the members of the Committee of the Swiss Circle Sri Lanka invited the members to a grand anniversary celebration at the Hilton Colombo Residence Ballroom on 14 September 2013.



After President Arlette Palmer's welcome address, Kurt Meier, Charge d'Affaires and Deputy Head of Mission, Swiss Embassy in Sri Lanka, thanked all who had helped and generously sponsored the evening. He highlighted the events of 1933 when fateful decisions were made in Europe which had an impact on the development of Europe and the rest of the world for decades. In the same year and thousands of kilometers away a small group of Swiss Citizens founded an association in Ceylon with the goal of helping Swiss expat compatriots in need. It was called "Schweizerischer Hülfsverein" and became later, after a few name changes, the Swiss Circle of Sri Lanka.

150 members and their guests enjoyed a pleasant evening with excellent Swiss food, accompanied by Swiss Music provided by the band "Kapelle Jungfrau", and later followed by the Sri Lankan band "Mirage". The special performance of Asitha Tennekoon, Tenor accompanied by Eshantha Peiries on the piano was a huge success.
